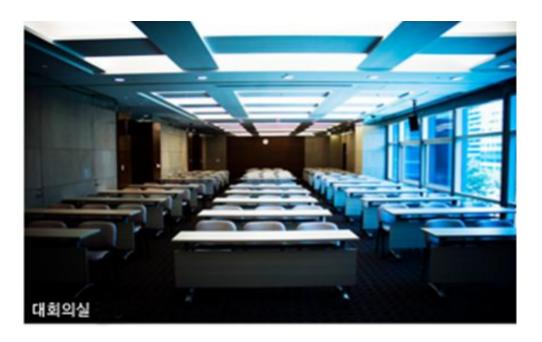
Venue (1/2)
