Also, a lot of students and developers want to know and learn about linux.

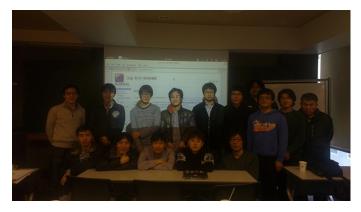
But, many people don't know about GNOME.
